A Micro-loan Program for Underprivileged Women and Their Children
in Sabanagrande, F.M., Honduras

*sponsored by St. Peter Mission Circle

*similar to Grameen Bank Micro-Credit Program

*developed by Fr. Joaquin, 10 years experience with micro-loans in Africa

WHAT: Each woman plans a business and receives a loan of \$300 for 6 months. After 6 months, she saves 10%, repays the loan with interest, and receives a new loan for \$300. This cycle is repeated until, in 5 years, she has saved \$300 and is self-sufficient. The women are organized in groups which are responsible collectively for the debts of their circle. An administrator, paid by the interest, oversees and counsels the women.
